This year’s Schedule and Presenters on the Wednesday Evenings of Lent are:

- **March 13, “The Canonization Process of the Church”**  
Presenter: Rev. Gregory Finn, OSJ, Director, Oblates of St. Joseph House of Formation, Philadelphia, PA
- **March 20, “St. Gianna Beretta Molla”, Wife, Mother, Physician, and Pro-Life Witness”** Canonized by Pope John Paul II on May 16, 2004.  
Presenter: Robert White, Director, St. Gianna Molla Shrine, Warminster, PA.  
Presentation will include opportunity to Venerate St. Gianna Relic.
- **March 27, “St. Jeanne Jugan, LSP”,** Foundress of the Little Sisters of the Poor, whose Religious name was Sr. Mary of the Cross; Canonized by Pope Benedict XVI on October 11, 2009. The Little Sisters of the Poor are celebrating 150 years of service to the poor in the USA this year.  
Presenter: Sr. Veronica Proffitt, LSP, Staff of Holy Family Home, Philadelphia
- **April 3, “Blessed Jerzy Popieluszko”,** Polish Priest and Chaplain of Poland’s Solidarity Movement, martyred by government agents in 1984; Beatified by Archbishop Angelo Amato in Warsaw, Poland on June 6, 2010.  
Presenter: Ms. Judith Kelly, of Arlington, VA, Author of a recent book about Father Jerzy in Poland and a summary of his travels in Canada and the USA, Just Call Me Jerzy
- **April 10, “Servant of God, Rev. William Atkinson, OSA”,** Upper Darby Native and Long-time Theology Teacher/Chaplain, Monsignor Bonner High School, Drexel Hill, PA, also First Quadriplegic Ordained a Priest in the Catholic Church in 1974; Process of Beatification and Canonization began on April 24, 2017.  
Presenter: Rev. Frank Horn, OSA, Congregation’s Treasurer, Long-time Friend and Classmate of Father Atkinson
